	The roads surrounding Little Billing Way, Conningham Drive, Ashmead and Orchard Hill are going to be used as an overflow carpark for The Academy School	
	Parking on the yellow lines will continue as there will be no enforcement	
	The safety of the school children	
	The residents and Cllrs. have suggested that the following be taken into consideration:	
	The yellow lines be extended onto the corners of Fishponds Road and onto Orchard Hill up to the junction with Russet Drive.	
	Installation of portable enforcement cameras (Domar) on lampposts to ensure that new restrictions are enforced.
