



PCSO Harrison has confirmed that he has checked the incidents logged and there have been no reports of anti-social behaviour involving kids trespassing through the fence or anti-social behaviour at the MUGA. Also, that the fence is in a poor condition and has been like this for some months. He has again suggested that any incidents are reported by phone on 101 or through the website Report antisocial behaviour Northamptonshire Police (northants.police.uk). Cllr. Chaggar asked if WNC could lock the gate to the MUGA any earlier than midnight. Cllr. Holland Delamere confirmed that this is unlikely due to one person covering the whole of WNC. Cllr. Chaggar suggested that maybe the landlord / land lady of the Deer's Leap Public House could be approached. Cllr. 
Ecton Brook Crime Stats (01/09/2023 – 08/10/2023)


