## Community Infrastructure Levy Regulation 62A Report

The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a charge on the amount of floor space created by new development. Its purpose is to raise funds for essential community infrastructure that is required across an area as the population grows.

West Northamptonshire Council (WNC) serves as the CIL collecting authority for our district. Billing Parish Council receives a share of the CIL raised within its parish biannually, in April and October, and is used for the parish's own priorities for local infrastructure projects.

To ensure transparency, both WNC and Billing Parish Council must publish a CIL report on an annual basis. This must be done by 31st December after the financial year end.
